I will be told where I can safely leave my bag and where the toilets are. There will also be time for recess and lunch. Everyone likes to know these things!



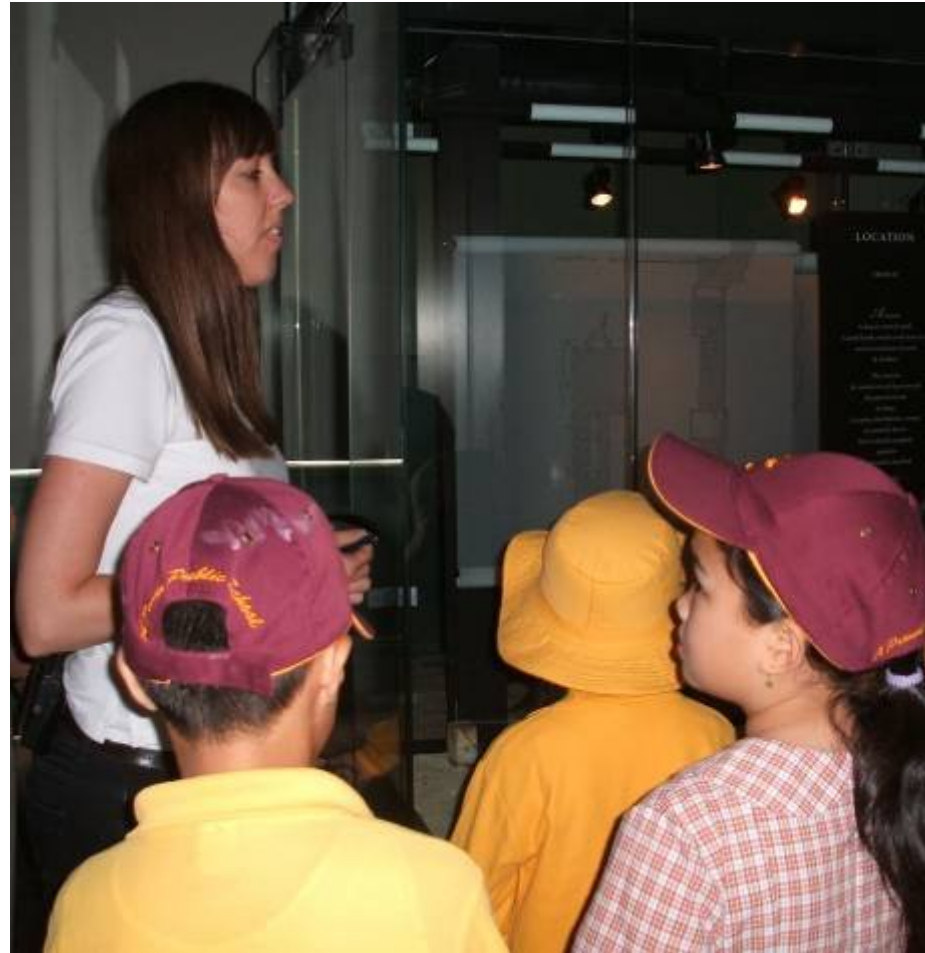
At the museum, the guide will explain the rules to me. I will be told when it is okay to touch certain things. Or even get on or inside things.
