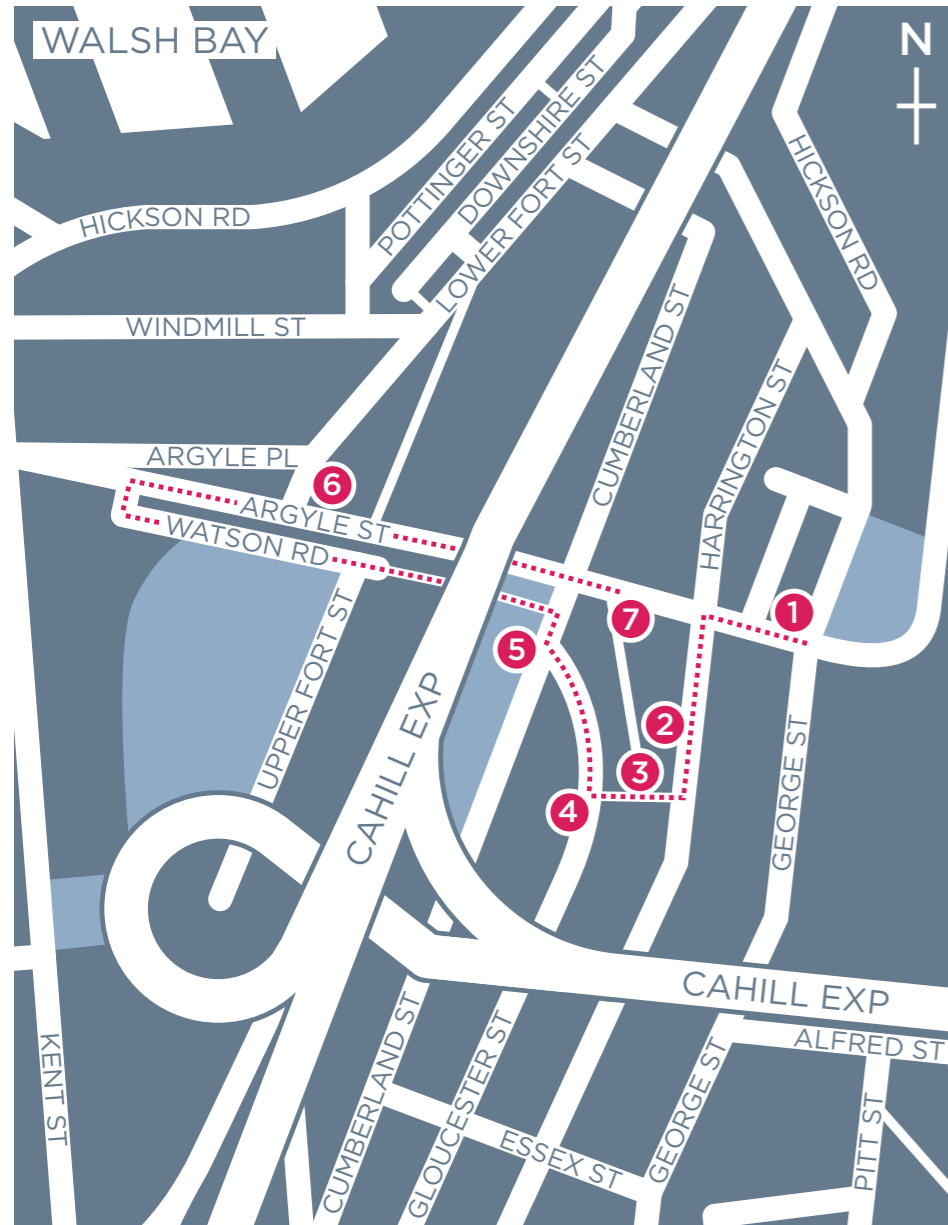


In 1902 Sydney artists painted The Rocks, which was then earmarked for demolition. This walking tour will help you find some of the places that were painted.

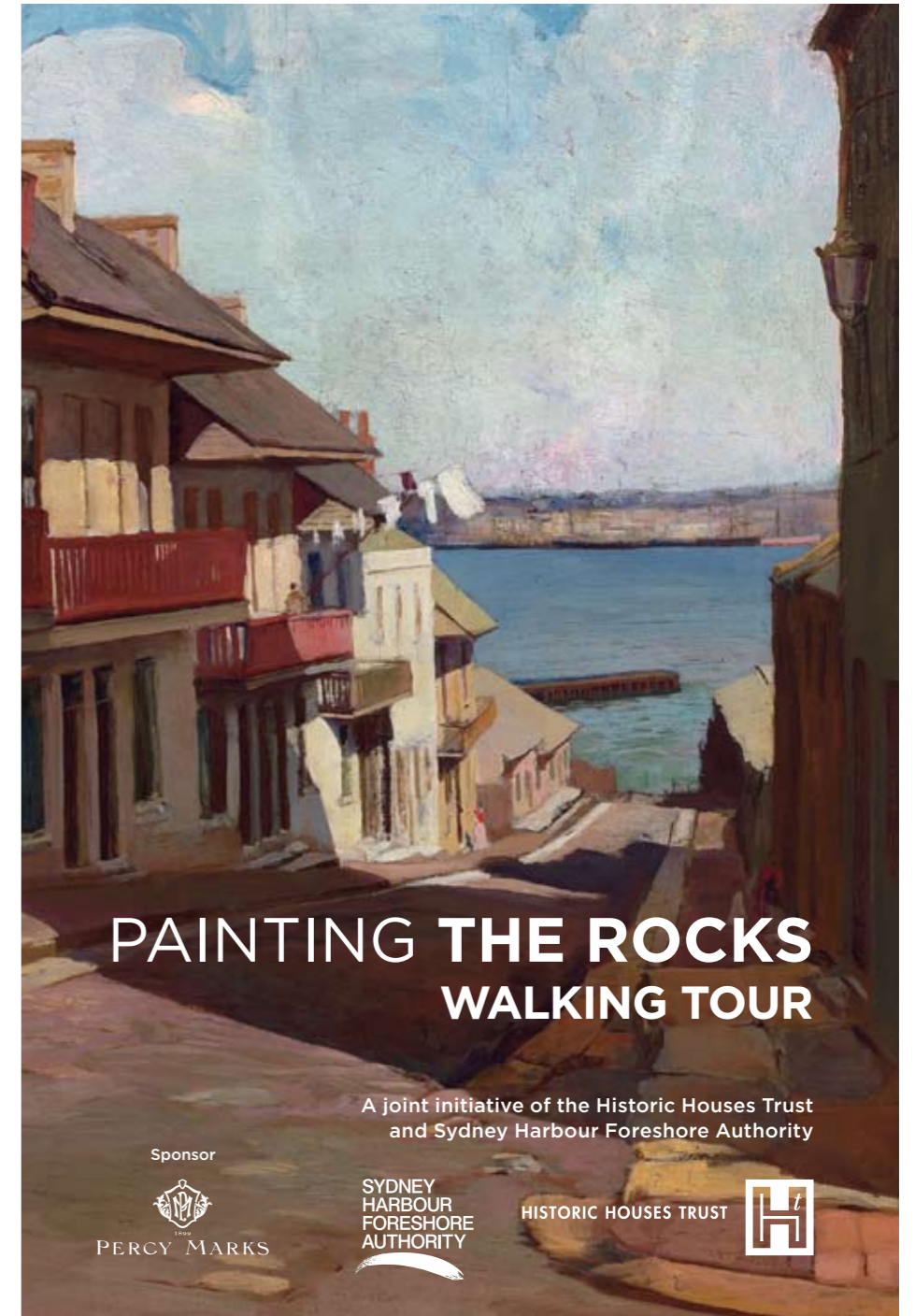
Nothing remains of Clyde Street today. It disappeared about 1909 when the area was quarried to create Hickson Road.
